Aetiopathogenesis

- Release of endotoxin of the spirochaetal breakdown products following treatment. These products are reacting with sensitised syphilitic to produce exacerbation of the lesion.
- Due to stimulation of the spirochaetes and inadequate education.
 Endotoxin of the bacteria — semi-permeable membrane — regulating — shed — Death of the organism
