Dr Wilhelm Janse van Rensburg holds a PhD from Stellenbosch University's Faculty of Military Science, entitled 'Twenty years of democracy: An analysis of parliamentary oversight of the military in South Africa since 1994'. He also holds a Master's degree in Security Studies (MSS) and a Honours Degree in International Relations from the University of Pretoria. His current research focuses on means to enhance parliamentary oversight and the accountability of parliaments as institutions. This field of study overlaps with broader research on civil-military relations in a South African context.

Dr Janse van Rensburg currently serves as the defence researcher for the Parliament of South Africa's Joint Standing Committee on Defence. Previously he worked as a security analyst focusing on country-specific political and security risk in Africa. He also served in various positions as an officer in the South African National Defence Force (SANDF) between 2002 and 2010.
