## **Creating a Page**

The page module enables a teacher to create a web page resource using the text editor. A page can display text, images, sound, video, web links and embedded code, such as Google maps.

Advantages of using the page module rather than the file module include the resource being more accessible and easier to update. For large amounts of content, it's recommended that a book is used rather than a page.



## A page may be used to:

- Present the terms and conditions of a course or a summary of the course syllabus
- Embed several videos or sound files together with some explanatory text
