

#### 1685

Stellenbosch University's history goes back as far as 1685 when regular schooling began in Stellenbosch.

#### 1859

In this year, higher education in Stellenbosch started with the establishment of the Theological Seminary of the Dutch Reformed Church.

#### 1866

In December 1863, the foundation was laid for the establishment of the Stellenbosch Gymnasium, which became a reality in 1866.

#### 1918

On 2 April 1918 Victoria College became Stellenbosch University after a donation of £100 000 by a local benefactor, Jan Marais.

#### 1887


The Victoria College is established as part of Queen Victoria's golden jubilee. From 1897 to 1900, the College was transformed with the building of several new facilities.




