



## **Call for applications: Erasmus+ Student mobility grant**

SU International is happy to send out a call for applications in the context of the Erasmus+ KA1 International Credit Mobility with our partner, University of Torino (UniTO), Italy.

<i>Target group:</i>	Registered Master's and PhD students in the broad fields of biochemistry, chemistry and pharmacy (see below for further details)
<i>Number of grants available:</i>	3
<i>Type of mobility:</i>	Student Mobility
<i>Period of mobility:</i>	6 months (maximum)
<i>Start of mobility:</i>	Late 2021 / 2022, exact dates determined in collaboration with academic collaborators, but mobility to be concluded by July 2022.

There is ongoing research collaboration between colleagues at Stellenbosch University, Department of Chemistry and Polymer Science and the Department of Drug Science and Technology at the University of Torino (UniTO). Eligible activities during the mobility at UniTO include:

- courses attendance and exam sessions;
- additional traineeships activities;
- additional research for final dissertation.

### *What is included in the grant?*

Travel costs to the value of 1500 Euros (flat rate) and a mobility stipend of approximately 850 Euros per month. Payments shall be made by UniTO to the participant in full (100%), including the contribution for travel, according to the following guidelines:

- any contract received within the 1st working day of the month shall be paid by 25th of the same month;



- any contract received by the 2nd working day of the month shall be paid by 25th of the following month.

The mobility period abroad shall last at least 3 months or 1 academic term or trimester, failure to comply will result in the restitution of the entire amount received. Should the participants waive their scholarship, the grant shall be given back.

Participants who end their mobility period before the scheduled date stated in the Grant Agreement will have to return the amount corresponding to the number of days the participant did not spend at UniTO multiplied per 1/30 of the unit cost per month.
