1. Message from the Chairman, André Kilian

On Saturday morning the 9th of March 2025 I parked at Stellenbosch High School to watch my boys play hockey. As I got out of the car, I noticed a student wearing a Helshoogte cap walking past me. I didn't think much of it, but when a third Helshoogte student passed me, I realised they were returning from Botmaskop, having just completed the annual Helshoogte first-years' Bergklim, a tradition all of us old Helshoogters participated in over the years. I knew exactly what it felt like, and I could still see my own Helshoogte Bergklim experiences vividly in my mind - 1993 as a first year, 1995 as a HK member and 1996/1997 as Prim. Although I didn't know the guy's walking passed me that morning, I felt like I did. Just before I entered the school, I saw two guys walking with a Helshoogte flag, and I decided to stop and talk to them – immediately there was a connection when I told them I was there too many years ago and without asking them they realised I know exactly where they were returning from. When I mentioned I was there in the 90's the one guy exclaimed: "My dad was on the HK in 1995". Turns out his dad (Leslie van Zyl Smit) and I had served on the HK together 30 years ago! Time flies yes, but for a moment time stood still for me.

Being part of the Hoender family is such a privilege. Life goes on and all of us transitioned into new challenges but that morning I realised that we are all connected, and we carry the Helshoogte flag in so many ways. There are so many of us making a difference around the world, but experiences like the annual Bergklim connect us

with so many other stories. As the Old Boys Committee, we want to keep things simple and keep these stories alive. But we want to make sure that there is a feed of news, stories, current happenings in Helshoogte and worldwide that we acknowledge and hold on to. We are part of something special and the current Helshoogters continue writing our story. What a privilege!

2. Alumni Forum Meeting

The purpose of the Residence Alumni Forum meeting on Wednesday, 9 April 2025 at the Alumni Clubhouse, was to discuss key updates and future plans for Stellenbosch University and its alumni community. Prof Deresh Ramjugernath, Rector and Vice-Chancellor, presented his vision for the University, followed by a review of the 2024 fundraising and alumni engagement efforts. The meeting also outlined the Homecoming 2025 programme, aiming to foster continued connection and collaboration among alumni. All Old Boys' associations were represented, and we, as Helshoogte, feel positive about what was shared, particularly that student affairs and residence communities will remain a central component of the SU experience and identity.


