



Project Manager Position

The Enterprise development unit of ELI Agri (www.eli.co.za) is looking for project managers for agricultural development projects (particularly bee and pig farming) in South Africa.

This role will be based in the Northern Cape, with offices in Olifantshoek (<https://goo.gl/maps/v9vtjjecuyu9xg2ra>), where the candidate is expected to be based. Remuneration will be discussed during the interview.

Requirements:

- Be a South Africa citizen OR have a valid SA work permit
- Must have a valid driving license, use of own car is essential
- Minimum 3 year diploma/degree in a relevant subject
- Must have strong proven organizational and administrative skills for effective project management (this includes general admin, budgeting, and reporting to funders)
- Minimum experience of 2 years full-time project management
- Good communication skills (per telephone and email) are essential
- Must be able to fulfil Key Performance Indicators to successfully implement projects within a specific timeline and within budget
- Knowledge of and experience in agricultural enterprise development will be advantageous
- Must be able to work with senior managers, small business owners, and specialists
- Enjoy solving daily challenges on behalf of the team and stakeholders
- Must have a learn-on-the-job attitude and be open to researching solutions for project challenges
- Have the drive and spirit to make things work and be a team player
- Must be willing to be based in the Olifantshoek area, Northern Cape

This position will include a 3 month probation period, whereafter a service provider agreement will be offered at the discretion of ELI. Applications that do not fulfil the basic requirements of this position will not be considered.
