The incumbent will be responsible for the following key performance areas.

Presentations to working groups, meetings, farmer days and market research presentations to relevant stakeholders. Collecting of input costs and calculating of enterprise budgets. Advisory: Writing of articles, newsletters and contributions to different media sources for publication. Compile and analyse comprehensive grain economic/market reports. Making projections and forecasts and interpret the findings for example supply and demand tables on grains. Attendance and presentations at farmer days.

Administration: Proof read minutes of the working meetings and assisting the Committee Officer. Writing of reports, facilitating and arranging meetings.

Information Sharing: Engage and liaise with relevant stakeholders in the grain industry/agriculture on agricultural policies. Assist members regarding concerns and challenges.

Interdepartmental Support: Support to Senior Economists in the team and marketing team
