

## **Insect Pest Identification Service**



We offer a service for insect and mite identifications, with the focus on fruit pests in the Western Cape Province. Specimens are preserved where possible, accessioned and entered into a database for future reference. Where necessary, samples are sent to experts for further processing.

Collecting samples:

- Collect fresh material into a container and, if possible, freeze the specimen as soon as possible.
- Label with the date and place of collection and the name of the collector. Supply any biological information, for example the host plant etc...
- Submit the sample as soon as possible.

Correct handling of samples will ensure that a more accurate identification can be made.

Please complete a submission form along with the specimen, which will ensure that you receive prompt feedback.
