


# Blended Teaching and Learning Short Course



The Centre for learning technologies offers lecturers an opportunity to engage with the educational theory and gain practical skills in a blended learning pedagogical approach. Over a 7 week period, you will work through online activities and readings. Week 1 and Week 6 includes a compulsory contact session in the form of a full day workshop.

The final product of those who attend the course, is a module that has been re-designed and aligned with the principles of blended teaching and learning. This accredited short course supports lecturers every step of the way and includes software, hardware and additional funding, to implement blended learning in your environment, for those who successfully complete the course.

The course is offered 3 times in the year. We require participants to commit fully to the course, i.e. complete all the activities as well as attend the 2 workshops.

Although lecturers do not pay for the course, there are costs involved. Therefore, registered participants who do not notify us in the case of no longer being able to attend the course in a timely manner, or who do not complete the course once they have begun, will be required to carry the full cost of the course.

Time commitment: 60 hours (including 2 x full-day workshops)  
Online component requires a maximum of 7 hours commitment per week
