Afrikaans and Dutch 278

Intermediate Studies in Afrikaans Language and Literature

With Afrikaans and Dutch 278, students continue their study of Afrikaans and Dutch language and literature.

Students take six components:

- Afrikaans lexicography
- Afrikaans syntax
- Naturalism and modernism in Dutch literature
- The Sestiger movement
- Literature before 1960
- **One** of the following electives:
 - Afrikaans language practice
 - Avant-garde and the Second World War in Dutch literature

Remarks

1. Afrikaans and Dutch 178 is a requirement for this module.
2. This module leads to Afrikaans and Dutch 318 and Afrikaans and Dutch 348.
3. Not all components of Afrikaans and Dutch 278 are necessarily offered in every academic year.

Assessment method

This module does not have any exams. Assessment details are provided for each component, but all work in the module is compulsory. A final mark consists of all tests, essays and assignments completed during the course of the year.

To pass the module, students have to:

- complete all work (tests, essays, assignments) in all the components, and
- achieve an average mark of at least 50%.
