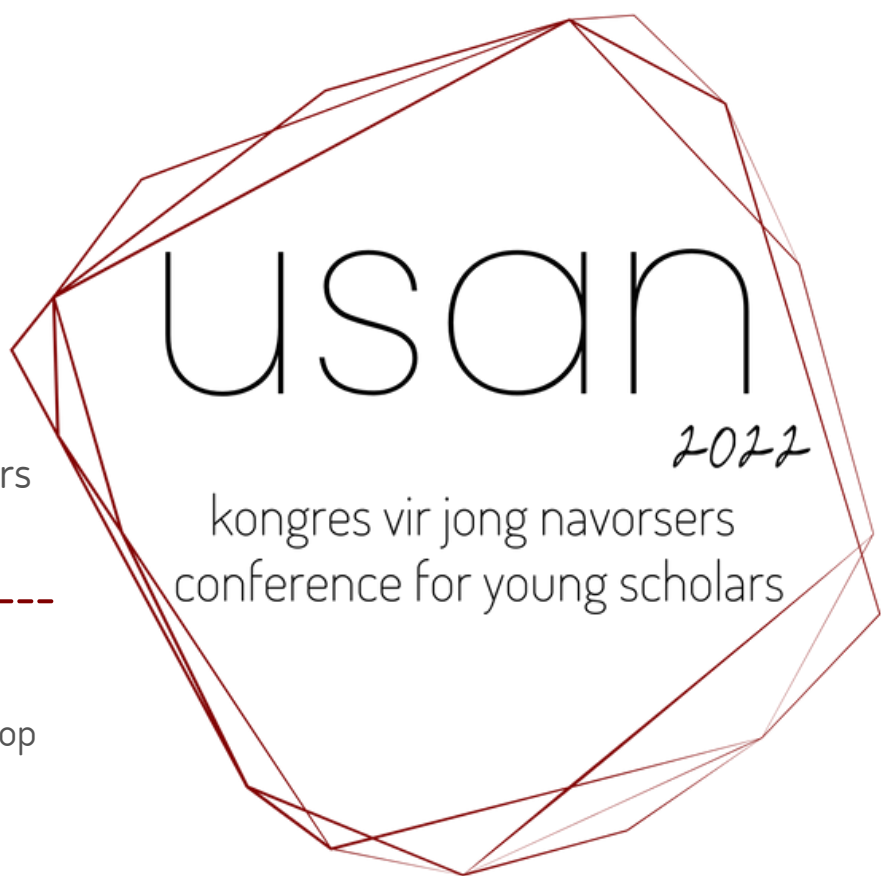

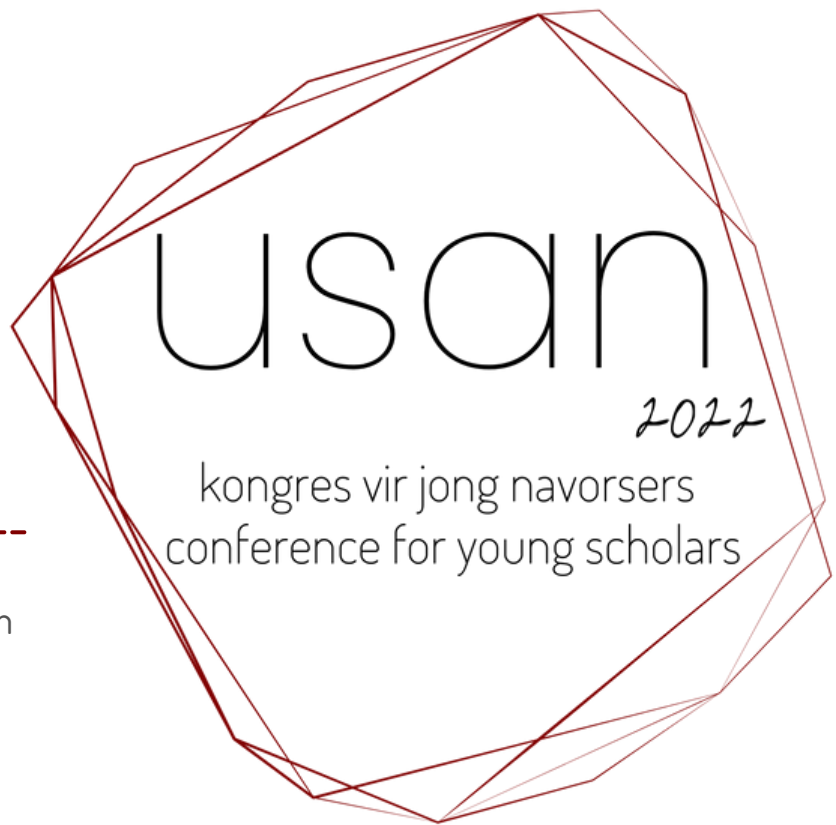

We invite all postgraduate students (PhD, Master's and graduated Honours students) and young researchers (who have graduated within the last five years) to submit proposals for one of the following formats:


- Paper (20 minutes)
