



Greek 172 and Hebrew 172 (hybrid): how to apply

These instructions are for students who will be taking the module while not enrolled for any programme at Stellenbosch University.

*NB: the deadline is **30 November 2023**. No applications will be possible after this date.*

- 1. Go to <https://student.sun.ac.za/signup>**
- 2. Create an application profile:**
 - Select 'New application' if you are new to Stellenbosch; select 'Current SU student' if you are currently a student
 - Fill in all your personal details and set up a password
- 3. Select your programme: special student (non-degree purposes)**
 - Click on 'Programme selection' and then click 'Add', and select the following:
 - Faculty: Arts and Social Sciences
 - Programme Type: 'Non-degree (special students)
 - Programme: 'Special student in Arts'
 - Application year: '2024'
- 4. Complete the following sections with your personal details:**
 - Personal Information
 - Address details
 - School information
 - Tertiary Studies
 - *Note that if you are an SU student, many of these details will be automatically filled in and you do not need to provide transcripts etc.*
- 5. Upload documents:**
 - Click on 'Guideline document' and choose 'Module application without motivation'
 - The form should download as word document
 - Provide details of the modules you wish to take:
 - Ancient Greek: Greek 172 (hybrid)
 - Biblical Hebrew: Biblical Hebrew 172 (hybrid)
 - Save the document
 - On the application form, click the green 'upload' button under 'Module application without motivation' and upload the document you have just filled in
 - *If you are a current SU student, you may not be able to upload documents. Instead, email the document, citing your student number and application details, to csaundrs@sun.ac.za*
- 6. Payment and agreement**
 - Read the application terms and conditions, and tick 'accept'
 - Select payment option for the R100 application fee
 - **Submit application!**
