

Career possibilities

The sought-after qualification of chartered accountant (CA) is an internationally acknowledged and highly regarded qualification. In addition to auditing companies' financial statements, chartered accountants are in demand for a number of other positions, e.g. as financial managers, management accountants and taxation experts.

To obtain the CA qualification, you first have to obtain the BAcc degree (three years) and the BAccHons degree (one year). Thereafter you have to pass the examinations of the South African Institute of Chartered Accountants (SAICA). Candidates must also meet SAICA's requirements for practical experience (a minimum of three years). The SAICA syllabus is aimed at preparing candidates in Financial Accounting, Management Accounting and Financial Management, Auditing and Taxation so that they can function as chartered accountants in the private and public sector.

You are required to follow all the prescribed modules in this programme. There are no optional modules. Admission requirements for the BAccHons programme include the BAcc degree and other requirements.

Our programmes are in great demand and our capacity is limited. Therefore all the Faculty's programmes are selection programmes. To be considered for the first round of selection, your application for admission must reach the University before 30 June. Late applications will be accepted up to and including 30 September.
