# Certificate Programme in Personal Mastery in Leadership

## INTRODUCTION

The Department of Industrial Psychology at Stellenbosch University has presented a Certificate Programme in Personal Mastery in Leadership (PML) since 2012. This leadership development programme has been presented to managers from various organisations and industries in the South African and Botswana's economies.

Leadership is about the ability to build vision, align people and execute strategy. Research has shown that leadership development can have a significant impact on the sustainable performance of managers, their teams and the organisation.

### **ABOUT THIS PROGRAMME**

The vision of the leadership programme is to develop managers' unique ethical behaviour and leadership effectiveness through self-awareness of development areas and applying of adult learning principles. The leadership development framework uses self-awareness, experiential learning and best practice leadership development principles, amongst others, to develop an individual leadership development plan tailor-made for each participant's organisational role, as well as the participant's personality, emotional intelligence, ethical leadership and current level of managerial leadership skills.

# WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

This programme is designed for managers in leadership roles who want to increase their organisational impact through more ethical and effective leadership.

The programme is offered on an in-house basis to individual companies or a group of qualifying participants from different companies and requires a minimum of five participants.

# BENEFITS TO THE ORGANISATION

Companies will benefit from the positive impact of the improvement in leadership effectiveness and ethical behaviour on business performance. Participants will also show a significant increase in motivation, focus and energy.

Our benchmark is a 25% improvement in the balanced scorecard performance of participating managers.

# **BENEFITS TO PARTICIPANTS**

After successfully completing the Certificate Programme in Personal Mastery in Leadership, participants will benefit through having gained the ability to:

- Identify own leadership **strengths** and challenges through **self- awareness** of their leadership approach and level of skill in different leadership competencies
- Gain insight into the impact of their **personality traits**, ethics and e**motional intelligence** on leadership behaviour
- · Develop a personal leadership vision and plan
- Understand and define actions and short-, medium- and long-term goals to address the leadership development areas
- Master the use of self-directed and experiential learning to develop leadership competencies.

# **ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

No formal tertiary qualifications are required. Participants should be in a managerial position with at least one year of experience in managing people. English language competence at NQF level 4 is assumed.

# **CERTIFICATION**

On successful completion of the programme, participants will receive a certificate from Stellenbosch University.

# DURATION

The Certificate Programme in Personal Mastery in Leadership is a two-month programme consisting of 18 hours of workshops, 3 hours of individual coaching and approximately 4 hours of assignment work.

The programme is aligned to competency level NQF 7.
