B.Com. (Actuarial Science)

Admission Requirements – 2021

Minimum requirements for admission:

- An NSC average based on the six best subjects, excluding Life Orientation, 80%
- Mathematics 80%
- Home Language 60%
- If the Home Language (in the requirement above) is not English, then also English First Additional Language 75%

The Bachelor's programme is a Selection Programme:

The Selection Mark, on which selections will be based is calculated as the average of a student's best 6 NSC marks (or best 4 where students have fewer than 6 subjects), including Mathematics and English/Afrikaans and excluding Life Orientation.

For automatic provisional acceptance applicants will need to have met the minimum admission requirements and have a selection mark of at least 85% (based on Grade 11 results, or NSC results if matriculated). Applicants with a selection mark of below 85% will then be considered on academic merit, taking account of the number of places available.
