

Scholarship Criteria

Criteria	Examples
Academic Merit	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Applicants should have achieved a minimum requirement of 65% in their previous degree to qualify for this scholarship. • Master's degree applicants must have achieved at least 60% for the research component of their Honours degree programme to qualify for the scholarship. • Applicants must have had a mark of at least 60% for their undergraduate degree and no less than 65% for their Honours degree to qualify for the Master's scholarships.
Financial need	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Applicants must attach proof of NSFAS funding to be considered for support due to financial need • Applicants must apply for the Postgraduate Support Bursary to be considered for support due to financial need. • Household income of less than R350 000 would qualify for support due to financial need.
Geographic consideration	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All nationalities may apply. • Applications are invited from all current and prospective students, regardless of nationality.
Degree/Project information	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Applications for the following degree programmes will be considered: BCom (Hons), MCom, PhD. • No applications for PG Diplomas or MBA degrees will be considered. • Coursework PG degrees must contain a minimum 50% research component to qualify • Only full-time degree applicants will be considered
Degree level specifications	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Applicants for doctoral scholarships should be accompanied by an approved proposal (or at least a pre-proposal). • Applicants should have applied for admission to the relevant degree programme
Personal history	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Applicants may not hold a qualification on the same degree-level or higher. • Applicants may not hold a full scholarship in conjunction with this award.
Process criteria	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All application must be accompanied by: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ a full academic record ○ a motivation letter ○ a CV ○ a research proposal (applications for Honours degrees excluded) ○ endorsement and support from a prospective supervisor • No late applications will be considered.
