







ABOUT THE JAKES GERWEL FELLOWSHIP

Founded in 2017, Jakes Gerwel Fellowship (JGF) has been funded by the Allan and Gill Gray Philanthropy to develop a high impact model of attracting top achievers into the teaching profession. The Fellowship offers graduate students access to a full Post Graduate Certificate in Education (PGCE) scholarship at one of six university partners. These beneficiaries are further supported through a two-year Newly Qualified Teaching programme that develops professional teaching competencies.

THE MODEL

At the heart of the Jakes Gerwel Fellowship is the commitment to nurture expert teachers who embrace innovation and lead change. An internationally acclaimed selection process helps identify high-potential applicants within the constraints of a highly unequal society. These passionate, young graduates are then supported and equipped through a world-class Fellowship programme that provides them access to personal coaches, mentors and expert teachers as well as structured communities of practice. Upon qualification as a teacher, the Newly Qualified Teacher programme has been designed together with leading international practitioners to further enhance teaching competencies in our beneficiaries. Additional programmatic focus on leadership and entrepreneurial pathways to impact serve to further support the longer-term, institutional impact of Jakes Gerwel Fellows.
