



MED IN EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT INFORMATION

Programme description

This two year part-time programme allows educators and facilitators from the formal and/or non-formal sectors to develop knowledge and skills needed to equip them to deal with the support and research needs of the ever-changing South African educational context. The three course work focus areas are Inclusive education, assessment and learning support; Support in school and community contexts; and Introduction to Qualitative Research.

The aim of the programme

This structured programme seeks to equip educators to identify the potential of learners with diverse educational needs in their unique educational context which can be formal and informal educational communities. Furthermore to identify, prevent and support learning barriers in schools and communities.

Duration and mode of the programme

This structured programme is presented over a minimum of two academic years. The mode of presentation is contact teaching on campus as well as via the SUNLearn platform. The intake for this selection programme is done biennially. Prospective students apply before 30 June of the preceding year of commencement.

Admission requirements

1. a HonsBEd degree or another four-year Bachelor's degree in Education approved for this purpose by the SU Senate; or
2. Obtained an Honours degree on NQF level 8 approved for this purpose by the SU Senate, and an approved education diploma/certificate (additional study in Education may be required of the candidates);
3. Obtained an overall average of 60% in their BEdHons or equivalent study;
4. Passed a module in research methodology at Honours level;
5. a Minimum of two years' formal teaching experience.

The application process for the 2019 intake closes on 30 June 2018
