WHO QUALIFIES?

Final year undergraduate students studying towards a degree in Physiotherapy, Speech-Language and Hearing Therapy, Dietetics and Occupational Therapy.

5th and final year undergraduate students studying towards a degree in Medicine and Surgery.

HERE'S HOW THE LOAN FUNDING WORKS

- Students should have or must open a Standard Bank transactional account to apply for the loan.
- Standard Bank will support students through the application process during application sessions at Tygerberg Campus;
- 3 Once a loan is approved, all study-related fees required will be paid directly to your SU fee account;
- The Tygerberg Campus Bursary office will provide administrative support for payments related to:
 - Programme and Accommodation fees
 - Books;
 - Meals;
 - Transport;
 - Equipment;
- 5) You will only start repaying this loan to Standard Bank once you start working*.

HOW TO APPLY

SU will invite you to open day sessions with Standard Bank where a Standard Bank agent will assist you with the loan application. Please bring along the required documentation as outlined below.

Required documents:

- Proof of SU Registration
- Proof of residence (where you are staying at the time of your application).
- Standard Bank transactional account / If you don't have one, Standard Bank will arrange to open one for you.
