Dr Xanthe Hunt is a Senior Researcher at the Institute for Life Course Health Research in the Department of Global Health at Stellenbosch University whose research focuses on mental health, disability, and child development in low- and middle-income settings. Dr Hunt has a PhD in Psychology from Stellenbosch University, and postgraduate training from Harvard Medical School. She currently leads a large-scale study on student mental health in South Africa, as well as a number of projects related to disability-inclusive development. She collaborates extensively with the World Health Organisation on work related to disability, and is on the secretariat of the forthcoming WHO-UNICEF *Global Report on Developmental Disabilities*.
