The Faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences (FMHS) of Stellenbosch University will be hosting its 63<sup>rd</sup> Annual Academic Day on **Wednesday, 21 August 2019**. This yearly highlight on the Faculty's calendar has become widely known as a showcase of the medical and health sciences research excellence of the staff and students of the FMHS.

The FMHS has a reputation for research built over decades of diligent and persistent effort and our research agenda is shaped by strategic research focus areas, ensuring that our research activities address the major health challenges facing the African continent. The Annual Academic Day is a showcase of the undergraduate, postgraduate and faculty research activities and is well attended by students from all the study years, staff of the Faculty and personnel of Tygerberg Hospital, as well as personnel from the Universities of Cape Town and the Western Cape and other visitors. At the Tygerberg Academic Campus there are approximately 3000 pre- and postgraduate medical students, 600 specialists, and a number of allied health professionals, in addition to other hospital and university staff. The campus and hospital complex has a staff component of about 7500 individuals. The Annual Academic Day has exposure in the local press and this increases public awareness and participation.

The basic format for the Annual Academic Day is based on 7 parallel tracks focusing on the thematic research focus areas of the Faculty, as follows:

- 1) Infectious Diseases
- 2) Non-communicable Diseases
- 3) Mental Health and Neurosciences
- 4) Violence, Injuries, Trauma and Rehabilitation
- 5) Maternal and Child Health
- 6) Health Systems Strengthening, and
- 7) Perioperative Sciences


