**Division of Health Systems and Public Health, Faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences,
invites you to apply for the following postgraduate programme:**

This SAQA accredited two-year, part-time programme is designed to develop knowledge, skills, and competencies in health care management at an advanced level to prepare graduates for specialized professional management practice in an applied work setting. The curriculum is based on workplace leadership and managerial roles. The programme includes 10 modules, practical assignments, and a professional report reflecting workplace experience and challenges. Modules include:

- Health systems, policy, and financing
- Leadership and innovation
- Strategy, marketing & communication
- Managing self and others
- Managing Operations
- Project Management
- Evidence and Information in health care
- Financial Leadership & Governance
- Managing Health Technology
- Quality Improvement & clinical Governance

The **target group** is senior managers in health care organisations, in the public and private sectors; clinicians and health professionals who manage health care practices.

Eligibility: Applicants should have a 3-year Bachelor's degree in a relevant discipline (health sciences, economic and management sciences, social sciences), on NQF Level 7 with relevant workplace experience, demonstrated academic ability and proficiency in English. An appropriate current or planned employment position in management recommended.

The programme extends over two years and is presented on a part-time basis.
