



## Figure A7.1 The median number of food items procured by HH's as determined by the FPHIQ by province: South Africa 1999\*


Figure A7.2 The median number of food items procured by HH's as determined by the FPHIQ by area of residence: South Africa 1999\*





## Figure A7.4 The median number of food items procured by and found in HH's as determined by the FPHIQ by area of residence: South Africa 1999\*






















Figure A7.12 The median number of food items consumed as determined by the 24-H-R in relation to income as obtained by the Census `96 and the S-DQ by area of residence:
