**ELIGIBILITY AND TARGET AUDIENCE:** Faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences **mid-career** and **established researchers** planning to submit NIH grant applications in the near future. Applicants who were previously unsuccessful in securing NIH grant funding will also benefit. **Previous attendance of a generic grant writing workshop is required.** *This event is free of charge* but only open to Stellenbosch University staff, joint staff in possession of a PhD, and postdoctoral fellows. A fee will be charged for printing and preparation of course work if the selected participants fail to attend. The selected applicants will be informed by Wednesday, 30 April 2025.

**PLEASE NOTE:** This is **NOT** a generic grant writing workshop; thus, suitable applicants will be selected. This full course is a prerequisite for the NIH K43 course that will be offered during June 2025.
