Purpose

- Assist new researchers with designing a clinical research study and putting together a sound research protocol
- Improve the quality of research projects

Target Audience

- FMHS postgraduate students or new researchers who are planning to embark on a quantitative research study in a clinical discipline at Masters or PhD level
- Only those who have already identified a research topic and are in the early stages of writing their protocols should apply
- MMed students are particularly encouraged to participate

Workshop Content

- Introduction to clinical research, Evidence-Based Medicine and protocol overview
- Formulating a research question
- Searching the literature and managing references
- · Writing a literature review
- Clinical study design
- Questionnaire design
- Biostatistical applications: Sample size and power calculations, sampling techniques
- Data management and analysis plan
- Ethical aspects
- Budget and timeline

Expected Outcomes

- This is a hands-on workshop where attendees will be given the opportunity to work on various stages of their own research protocol under the guidance of the facilitators
- By the end of the workshop attendees are expected to have worked on the major sections of the protocol and have a clear idea how to complete the rest of the protocol
