# FACULTY OF MEDICINE AND HEALTH SCIENCES OPEN ACCESS PUBLICATION FUND (FMHS-OAF) APPLICATION FOR FMHS-OAF

#### **Purpose**

The purpose of the Faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences Open Access Publication Fund (FMHS-OAF) is to provide financial support to FMHS early-career staff, postdoctoral fellows and postgraduate students towards Article Processing Charges (APC) of research publications in peer-reviewed Department of Higher Education and Training (DHET)-accredited open access or hybrid journals. Open Access publications refer to peer-reviewed publications that are published online and are freely available immediately after publishing. Hybrid publications refer to peer-reviewed publications in subscription-based journals with fee-based open access options for individual articles.

Please also consult the SU Library list of publishers with whom SU has agreements for reduced or waivered APC.

#### **Eligibility**

**FMHS** early-career staff, having obtained a PhD degree within 5 years, or a medical specialist qualification, e.g. MMed or CMSA, within the last 10 years; or **FMHS** postdoctoral fellows or **FMHS** postgraduate students, as <u>first</u> <u>author</u>. Undergraduate students must apply to the <u>Undergraduate Open Access Fund</u>. In addition:

- The journal must be **peer-reviewed** and **accredited by the DHET** and listed on one of the **DHET-approved indices**. Post-publication open peer review articles do not qualify for FMHS-OAF support. Articles in non-accredited journals or so-called 'predatory' journals are not eligible for FMHS-OAF support.
- The article must be a **DHET subsidy-bearing** publication (case reports and protocols typically do not qualify).
- All FMHS researchers' **Stellenbosch University** and **FMHS affiliation** should be indicated on the article.
- Only **one application** per article may be submitted, despite the number of affiliated co-authors.
- The article must either have been published or accepted for publication by the time of application.
- Since the purpose of this fund is to assist early-career researchers and postgraduate students who do <u>not</u> have any access to funding to publish, **only authors not having dedicated grant funding for APC are eligible to apply**.

#### **Award**

Awards will be made supporting 100% of the APC for the prorated FMHS authors with official FMHS and SU affiliations, up to a maximum of R 30 000 per publication, pending the availability of funding. If more than one application is submitted by an author in a calendar year, priority will be given to first-time applicants. Funding awards may be amended or suspended at any point, depending on the availability of funding.

Successful awards will be paid into the nominated **cost centres**, regardless of whether the authors have already paid the publisher's invoice or not. **It remains the authors' responsibility to pay the actual publisher's invoice.** 

### **Application**

Applications can be submitted at any time during the year.

NOTE: The relevant APC invoice date must not be older than 2 months by the time of application.
