Dr Ntozakhe Simon Cezula is a lecturer of Old Testament in the Department of Old and New Testament at Stellenbosch University (SU). He obtained BTh, MDiv, LicTheol and PhD Old Testament at Stellenbosch in 2005, 2006, 2007 and 2013, respectively. He started at the Faculty of Theology, SU, in 2014 and is still on the same faculty. In 2022 he became the Head of the Department, and he still is. From January to June 2023, he acted as chair of the Transformation Committee. He is also the chair of the Winter School of the faculty.

His research focus is the Second Temple Literature, specialising in the Books of EzraNehemiah and Chronicles. He is also a practising minister of the Uniting Reformed Church in Southern Africa (URCSA), serving the Overberg congregation of URCSA, a combination of Grabouw and Hermanus. He is a member of the Society for Biblical Literature (SBL) and the current treasurer of the Old Testament Society of South Africa (OTSSA).
