Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens, Slave Lodge and MOCAA Museum

Our first stop is <u>Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens</u> in Cape Town. Kirstenbosch is acclaimed as one of the great botanic gardens of the world. Few gardens can match the sheer grandeur of the setting of Kirstenbosch, against the eastern slopes of Cape Town's Table Mountain.

The group visits <u>Green Market square</u> and <u>The Iziko Slave lodge</u> after lunch. The Slave Lodge is a South African social history museum located in Cape Town. It has been on its present site in the Company's Garden since it was built.

The last item on the menu today is the Zeitz Museum of Contemporary Art Africa, a public not-for-profit contemporary art museum that collects, preserves, researches and exhibits 21st-century art from Africa and its diaspora in 100 galleries, set within reimagined historical grain silos.

We drive down to the coast to visit <u>Camps Bay</u>, world renowned, known for its fine white sand, natural rock swimming pool and views of the Twelve Apostles mountains.

Next stop is <u>Hout Bay</u>, a cozy fishing village nestled in the mountains, boasting the most picturesque bay, followed by Chapman's Peak Drive: Chapman's Peak is the name of a mountain on the western side of the Cape Peninsula. The Scenic beauty and the engineering genius making this drive absolutely breathtaking.

We then drive to <u>Cape of Good Hope</u> or Cape of Storms or more commonly known as Cape Point: The Cape of Good Hope is a rocky headland on the Atlantic coast of the Cape Peninsula, South Africa. Lunch at Two Oceans Restaurant.

<u>Boulders Beach Penguin Sanctuary</u>: Boulders Beach is a sheltered beach made up of inlets between granite boulders, from which the name originated. It is home to one of the African Penguin Sanctuaries and a great tourist attraction.
