

WHAT IS CLUSTER?

Being a part of your student community also entails forming part of a bigger community on campus, called the Wimbledon Cluster. A cluster is a larger student community that comprises of various residences and CSC's.

The concept of cluster was introduced in 2007 to scale academic success across campus and establish an integtrated learning community, with the activities and facilities available to students part of university residences and CSC's to, and engage in each others activities. The six other clusters on campus in addition to the Wimbledon Cluster include Validus, Rubix, amaMaties, VicMeyer, Victoria and Tygerberg.

Wimbledon Cluster consists of six communities that are all in the area surrounding the Wimbledon Hub. These include Aristea CSC, Vesta CSC, Eendrag Residence, Helshoogte Residence, Irene Residence, and Sonop Residence.







How do shuttles and walking groups work?

Shuttles

Shuttle services are available throughout the Welcoming period but will not operate beyond this timeframe. These shuttles are completely free of charge during Welcoming, provided bookings are made before the daily cut-off time of 11:30 PM. Operating on a pre-booking basis, the shuttles depart from campus to designated drop-off points at 7:00 PM and 9:00 PM. On special occasions such as Dream Walk and Vensters, shuttles will run later, as per the University's schedule. Drop-off points include police stations located 5-10 km outside Stellenbosch, ensuring safety and accessibility for all passengers.

Walking Groups

If you're concerned about attending evening events due to safety worries, don't worry—we've got you covered! Navigating an unfamiliar town in the dark can feel unsafe, but we're here to help. In collaboration with Vesta, the male CSC in our cluster, we've organized walking groups to ensure everyone gets home safely at night. There are four designated walking routes that will remain consistent throughout the welcoming period. These groups will depart every day that the welcoming program ends at 21:00 providing a secure and reliable way to get home. Have a look at the walking routes on the next page!

Will I have accommodation?

Aristea is **NOT** a residence and therefore **DOES NOT** offer accommodation. We urge you to find accommodation before coming to Stellenbosch University, even if you are still awaiting residence placement. Being placed in an SU residence is not guaranteed!



ACCOUNTS 2025 Welcome to your Commuter Student community at Stellenbosch University! You have been assigned to a CSC (Commuter student Community) as you have not chosen to stay in an SU residence in 2025.

During the annual welcoming period in the beginning of the year, communities take responsibility for exposing first years to Stellenbosch University in a welcoming manner.

Because CSCs do not have a dining hall (although some CSCs will arrange meals for their students in dining halls during the welcoming period) where students can enjoy meals, CSC first years are provided with "welcoming packages". These packages usually consist of several meals, clothing, and other items unique to each community. During CSC registration on the first day of Welcoming (Tuesday 28th January 2025), you will have the option of purchasing one of these welcoming packages at a set price (which may vary from community to community). Each CSC will also offer different options (both clothing and meals, only meals, only clothing, etc.) that students can then select. Please see the bottom of this email for more information.

Stellenbosch University utilizes a cashless system to allow students to purchase these packages hassle free. You, or your parents or guardian, will have to sign an acknowledgment of debt on the day so that the clothing, food, etc. for the welcoming period can be made available to you. After registration the cost will be charged to your student account to be paid with all other student-related expenses. Please note that once the form is signed you will be liable for the costs of the package selected, regardless of you having all the meals or not, or not wanting the clothing after the first few days.

Acquiring the "welcoming packages" is not compulsory, but we do want to encourage you to take the opportunity to do so as it will make your welcoming period a much more enjoyable experience. Please find attached the form for your completion. You are welcome to print the form and bring it along.


