

2019 MQA Bursary Application Form (New Intake)

NB: This application form must only be completed by new bursary applicants. Existing MQA bursars must complete the 2019 Continuation Bursary application form.

Please **READ** carefully the **CRITERIA** and **INSTRUCTIONS** below before completing, signing and submitting the application form. Failure to follow the instructions in the form will result in the application being disqualified.

CRITERIA

1. The bursary is available to financially needy and deserving applicants who are unemployed South African Citizens not older than thirty-five (35) years of age.
2. The bursary is only available to applicants who want to pursue their studies at a South African university, university of technology, or a TVET college. Applications to study at a private institution will not be considered.
3. The bursary is not available to applicants who wish to pursue a post-graduate qualification.
4. Only applications to study MQA approved disciplines (qualifications) will be considered. Please refer to page 5 for the list of MQA approved disciplines.
5. Preference will be given to applicants who have applied to study at their local tertiary institutions.
6. The awarding of the bursary is at the sole discretion of the MQA and communication will only be entered into with the pre-selected candidates. The MQA also reserves the right not to award a bursary to any pre-selected candidate(s).
7. Successful candidates will be required to enter into a bursary contractual agreement with the MQA, and not to accept any other form of financial assistance from other source(s) to fund their studies, whilst being funded as an MQA bursar.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Ensure that this form is completed in full, and in **BLOCK LETTERS**. An application form that is incomplete, and submitted with incomplete supporting documents, disqualified.
2. The application form must be submitted **TOGETHER** with all the required supporting documents.
3. Completed application forms with the required supporting documents can be hand-delivered at, or posted to, any of the address indicated on page 5.
4. Due to the expected large number of applications, the MQA will not be able to acknowledge receipt of your application, and communication will only be entered into with the pre-selected applicants. If you have not been contacted within two (2) months of the closing date of the 2019 applications, then please accept that your application was unsuccessful.

5. Late / faxed / e-mailed application forms will **NOT** be considered.
