- 4. Inform the SRC of all developments at the Military Academy and that concerns from the Military Academy are raised in SRC discussions. Also ensure the SRC decisions/information is communicated with the Military Academy.*

## Committees/Task Teams

---

- 1. There are two committees under the DSSC portfolio which forms part of the MASC which are the Men's forum and the Women's forum. The purpose is for both forums to have a platform to address Gender-Based Violence and other gender-based issues that may arise.*
- 2. Social/Diversity: Social/Diversity sub-committee composed of each year group social rep; 1<sup>st</sup> Years rep, 2<sup>nd</sup> Years rep, 3<sup>rd</sup> Years rep, post-grads rep and Trans-Enduro rep to integrate all planned activities.*
