UNIVERSAL ACCESS

We'll gladly provide universal access to guests with mobility challenges who need parking close to faculty venues. Please inform us ahead of time by sending an email to events@sun.ac.za.

PARKING

Stellenbosch:

- All the security booms at our on-campus parking areas will be lifted (as they usually are on a Saturday), so you should be able to find centrally located parking.
- There will also be ample parking available at the Faculty of Engineering. This parking area is accessible from Bosman Street and is within walking distance from all the other Stellenbosch-based faculties as well.
- To be safe, do not leave any valuables inside your vehicle in plain sight of passers-by.
- Please do not park on sidewalks or in nondesignated parking areas, as this might attract a fine from municipal law enforcement.
- Note that there may be sporting events taking place at Coetzenburg sport complex, which might affect traffic flow to and from Stellenbosch. Please allow sufficient time to get to your venues.
- If you choose to park around Coetzenburg sport complex, look out for the shuttle service running to and from the central campus.

Tygerberg:

 Please enter through the main campus entrance. Ample parking is available close to the Faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences' Education building, where most of the day's activities will take place.

Specialised walk in-sessions

Some general pointers for booking your ticket

The Open Day is a **free event**. (Quicket will still refer to payment, but you won't be charged.) Nevertheless, to avoid disappointment and ensure guests' comfort and safety, booking is essential for **tours and information** sessions.

Consider the following when booking your ticket:

- Bookings are restricted to one student and two adults. (In the case of twins or multiple siblings, please make two bookings.)
- For school group bookings, please email our Central Events and Conferencing Office at events@sun.ac.za with details of the sessions you wish to attend and the number of seats to be reserved.
- Carefully consider the programme and allow enough travel time between sessions and venues.
- Doors will close 5 minutes after the session has started, after which no guests will be permitted to enter the venue.
- No guests will be permitted to leave sessions early, as this disturbs fellow guests and the presenter.
- Consult the campus mapto determine your routes and timing between venues.
- Should you be unable to attend a session (or the day as a whole), please cancel your seat to allow others the opportunity to attend.


