

MMil in Military Science (Research)

This degree is interdisciplinary, with a broad focus on military and defence-related topics.

Admission Requirements

A BMilHons degree, or a degree in a cognate discipline, with a final average mark of 65%. If you do not possess a BMilHons, you may be requested *to undertake guided reading before you are the programme*.

Duration of Programme

This MMil programme runs over two years on a part-time basis.

Programme Structure

The degree comprises two phases:

- (1) the successful completion of the module 'Interdisciplinary research methodology' and the successful defence of a research proposal; and
- (2) the completion of a thesis on a military-related topic as well as the submission of a journal article on the same topic.

Programme Contents

Compulsory for all candidates:

- Interdisciplinary research methodology (30)
- Thesis (150)
