About the job

We invite applications for a postdoctoral fellowship. This position is ideal for researchers interested in quantitative methods and systematic reviews. If you are detail oriented and a strategic thinker with an understanding of health or disability, we are looking for you!

About the Fellowship

The selected Fellow will join the Faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences and work with the commissioners of the Lancet Commission on Disability and Health, undertaking systematic reviews of disability and health. The Fellow will collaborate with a transdisciplinary team of leading researchers, receive hands-on training in systematic review processes, paper writing and be mentored by scientists who publish in top-tier journals such as Nature and The Lancet. The Fellow will lead the authorship team on at least one systematic review to be published in a high impact journal. They will publish 6 reviews over the two years.

Applicants must be citizens or permanent residents of South Africa to be eligible for this position. We are unable to provide visa sponsorship.

Location: Tygerberg campus, Stellenbosch University, South Africa

Duration: Up to 2 years

Annual fellowship amount: ZAR450,000 per annum tax-free

Essential Requirements:

PhD (or equivalent) in a relevant field, obtained within the last 5 years
Expertise in at least one key area: quantitative methods, epidemiology, statistics
Proven experience in literature reviews

Strong publication record

Desirable Qualifications:

Research experience in health or disability

Experience working in transdisciplinary teams
