



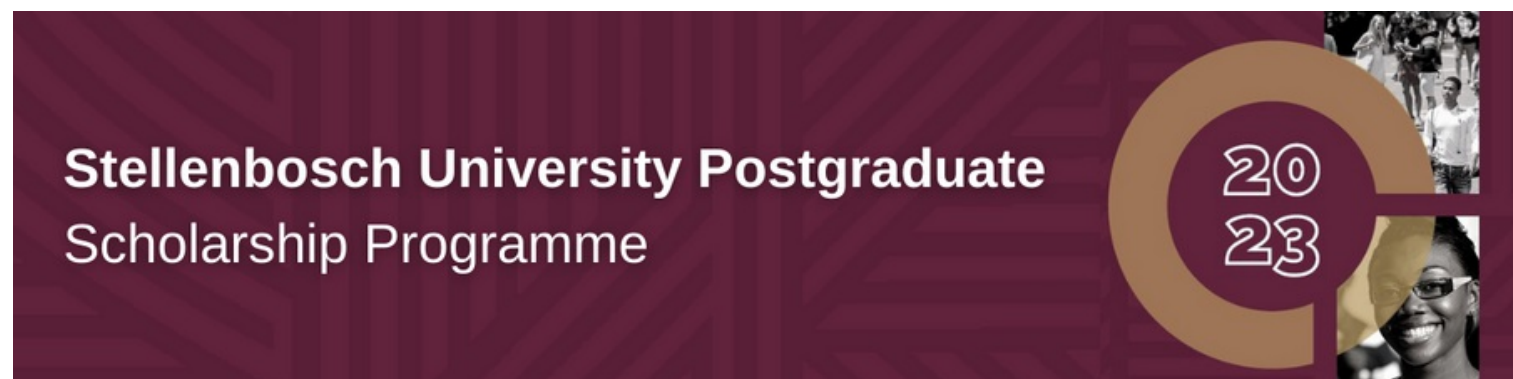

Stellenbosch University Postgraduate Scholarship Programme (PSP) 2023

The Stellenbosch University Postgraduate Scholarship Programme (PSP) is one of our flagship scholarship programmes. It aims to strengthen SU's vision of becoming a leading research-intensive University by supporting a pool of emerging research talent amongst our postgraduate students.

All scholarship awards will be made on the condition that the applicant meets all the requirements of the scholarship as well as the admission requirements of the relevant degree programme.

Kindly note that there are two separate application processes – the application for postgraduate study (degree programme) and the application for this scholarship programme.

Students who will be pursuing postgraduate studies in Honours, Master's, or PhD degrees in 2023 may apply, as per the faculty criteria provided in the call document.

Imperial and Stellenbsch University collaboration initiative bursary

Imperial's collaboration initiative with Stellenbosch University focuses on investing in the future of Africa. This multi-disciplinary research project aims to address and resolve logistics and supply chain challenges, ensuring cross-pollination between the industry and academia and inter-field collaboration. Studies focus on healthcare supply chain, cold chain supply chain and behavioural economics.

Students participating in this collaboration initiative are registered for Master's and PhD degrees and are selected from diverse backgrounds, with preference given to previously disadvantaged students. The long-term goal of this collaboration initiative is to identify talent and further cement Imperial as a partner of choice for employees, clients and suppliers.

The Postgraduate Office (PGO) Overseas Conference Grant (OCG) is a supplementary award for senior SU postgraduates to present a paper or a poster at an international conference outside of South Africa. Applicants must be in their final year of their Master's degree or registered for a doctoral degree at Stellenbosch University. The maximum award is R15 000. Preference will be given to applicants invited to deliver oral presentations.

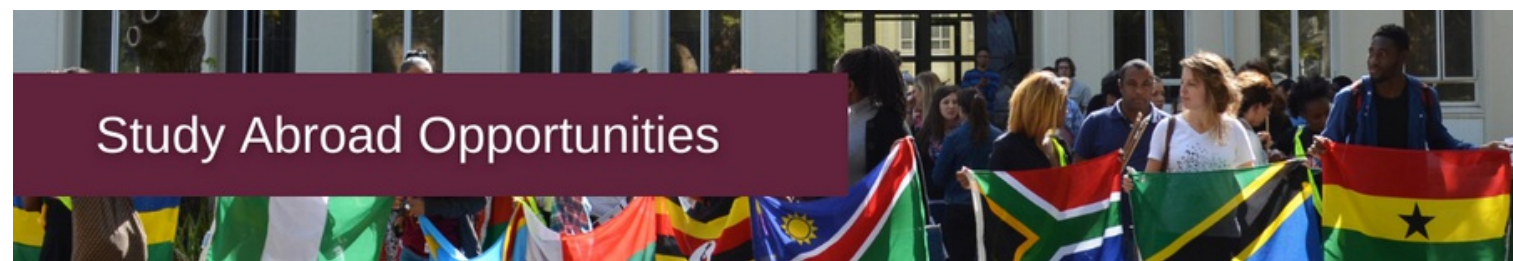
