

Zubeida Jaffer

for her outstanding contribution to the South African media industry, her commitment to factual and accurate reporting so as to inform and empower, and sharing her knowledge to guide a new generation of journalists.

Ms Zubeida Jaffer is an award-winning South African journalist, author and activist. She started her career at the daily newspaper *Cape Times* in 1980 and later helped develop local community papers such as *Grassroots* during the time of resistance to apartheid.

She was the founding editor of Independent Newspapers' parliamentary bureau, serving 14 newspapers across South Africa. Her articles have appeared in newspapers across Africa as well as further afield, such as Japan, India, the United Kingdom and United States.

Jaffer holds a master's degree from Columbia University in New York and is a research fellow at the University of the Free State. Committed to safeguarding the future of free and accurate reporting, she is also the publisher of the website *The Journalist*. This ground-breaking platform provides context on key issues facing South African reporters, equipping journalism students with a uniquely South African perspective of the profession.

She is the first woman in Africa to have won the coveted foreign journalist award from the United States National Association of Black Journalists. Her work has also earned her numerous other local and international awards. for his outstanding contribution to psychiatry and psychology, his commitment to community service through the promotion of mental health initiatives in the developing world, and his generosity in sharing his knowledge to develop students, academics and practitioners in his field of expertise.

Prof Vikram Patel, a psychiatrist and mental health expert, is a leading figure in the global mental health movement, and a key contributor to the promotion of mental health and the prevention of mental disorders in low and middle-income countries.

This excellent scholar is the Pershing Square Professor of Global Health in the Department of Global Health and Social Medicine at Harvard Medical School's Blavatnik Institute. His work focuses on the burden of mental health problems, their link with social disadvantage, and the use of community resources to prevent and treat them. Patel also has strong links with Stellenbosch University, having co-published and co-researched with several researchers of the University.

Named as one of *Time* magazine's 100 most influential people in 2015, he has been a key figure in convincing governments and international agencies that paying attention to mental health should form a cornerstone of all development efforts worldwide.

He is a co-founder of the Movement for Global Mental Health, the Centre for Global Mental Health at the London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine, as well as the Mental Health Innovations Network. Patel also helped establish Sangath, an Indian non-profit organisation, which won the World Health Organisation's Public Health Champion of India prize.

GROENEWALD, Liezl Marié (Applied Ethics)

The moral justifiability of hydraulic fracturing assessed against the Principle of Double Effect

This study investigates whether fracking can be morally justified when assessed against the principle of double effect. This principle emanates from the just war tradition and holds that an action that is aimed at a good effect, but produces harmful side-effects can be morally acceptable under specific conditions. Having subjected the arguments of proponents and opponents of fracking in the Karoo basin to the conditions of the principle of double effect, the study finds that fracking cannot be morally justified in terms of this moral decision-making framework. It is also demonstrated that the principle can be productively applied to non-war situations.

IIRMDU, Tina Odinakachi (Geography and Environmental Studies)

A chaos theory approach to understanding the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on tourism businesses in Plateau State, Nigeria

This study applies a chaos theory approach in investigating the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on tourism businesses in the Plateau State of Nigeria. Empirical evidence has confirmed the futility of the one-size-fits-all approach associated with deterministic linear models in crisis management. This study emphasises that there is indeed no standardised recipe for confronting crisis, but that each crisis is unique and, therefore, demands a unique response. Chaos theory teaches us to be concerned and sceptical about long-term predictions of recovery in the complex tourism system following the pandemic due to instability and uncertainty.

MAFAME, Thendo (Urban and Regional Planning)

Beyond procedural planning: Advancing the exploration of placemaking for urban public space improvements in South Africa

This study aims to explore placemaking processes in planning theory, and the influence of private organisations that target spatial improvements in urban areas. This is achieved by investigating comprehensive and communicative procedural planning practices and how these can enable collaborative placemaking. Virtual qualitative research methods such as semi-structured interviews, focus group discussions and virtual observations are used to examine multiple case studies. The study significantly contributes to the development of localised spatial and urban planning practices, both internationally and locally. In developing a method, it assists existing planning organisations and local governments to redefine their approach to planning.

NGILA, Dorothy Mutheu (Science and Technology Studies)

African academies of science as science advisers: The case of South Africa and Uganda

Science academies are associations of scientists that promote scientific excellence in the context of national service delivery and form an integral part of a science advisory ecosystem. This study examines the role of African academies as science advisers, focusing on the Academy of Science of South Africa (ASSAf) and the Uganda National Academy of Sciences (UNAS). It applies a qualitative case study design with the two academies as institutional cases, and three examples of a specific science advisory mechanism – the consensus study – as embedded cases. Several themes are highlighted, together with recommendations for the uptake of consensus studies by decision makers.

O'KENNEDY, Karien (Science and Technology Studies)

Wine scientists and winemakers as two communities: Bridging the gap through boundary-spanning activities

Researchers and practitioners have been described as two communities operating in different worlds and having different evaluation systems. To enable knowledge transfer, effective boundary-spanning activities must be in place. This study investigates the knowledge-related interactions between South African winemakers and the oenology researchers at a South African university. The role of intermediaries is also investigated. Research methods include interviews with all oenology researchers at the chosen university, an online survey of winemakers, as well as interviews with selected winemakers and intermediaries. The study makes recommendations for the parties involved in oenology knowledge transfer and contributes to the academic engagement literature.

OKIMAIT, David (Sociology)

The experiences and perspectives of alone and unaccompanied refugee children living in Uganda: Evidence from a child-centric approach

Alone and unaccompanied refugee children are housed in migrant settlements in Uganda, yet little is known about how such childhoods are experienced. This study explores these children's reflections on their forced migration and how they negotiate their everyday lives, alone and unaccompanied by adult kin in new social spaces. Primarily motivated by the 'new' sociology of childhood, the study uses participatory and child-centred methodologies that appreciate children as experts of their own childhoods. It concludes that child refugees construct their childhoods as processes of becoming as they negotiate their lives within the constraints of forced migration and the institutions of refugee settlements.

ROMMELSPACHER, Amy Fairbairn (History)

Work, wedlock and widows: Comparing the lives of coloured and white women in Cape Town, 1900–1960

This historical study explores the lives of coloured and white women in Cape Town from 1900 to 1960. Themes that are investigated include marriage age, employment trends, family structures, living standards, wages and the gender wage gap. Aspects such as whether or not they were employed in paid labour played a pivotal role in these women's own social position as well as in society as a whole. Ultimately, this study outlines some of the factors that shaped the lives of coloured and white women in early 20th-century Cape Town.

The Time of Activism: An ethnographic study on the Philippi Horticultural Area (PHA) Campaign and its practices of "working" time and representation in Cape Town

This ethnographic study focuses on everyday practices of environmental activism of the Philippi Horticultural Area (PHA) Food & Farming Campaign in Cape Town. It focuses on how these activists represent small-scale and commercial farmers, farmworkers and informal settlement residents in the PHA. The activists draw on both 'slow activism' and the politics of the instant media spectacle to challenge private developers who seek to build shopping malls and housing in the PHA. These activist struggles, which straddle the spaces of courts and both mainstream and social media, are part of wider environmental struggles against mining and urban development elsewhere in the world.

ZWEIG, Patricia Jane (Geography and Environmental Studies)

Deconstructing vulnerability: exploring the lives of young black men in urban informal settlements

Adopting an interpretivist theoretical approach and 'vulnerability' as an analytical lens, this study seeks to understand the challenges facing young Xhosa men living in informal settlements in contemporary South Africa. In navigating life on the margins, they are found to shift their identity interchangeably to reduce their perceived vulnerability. Traditional tenets of masculinity, perpetuated during cultural rites of passage, suggest that a more nuanced, Afro-centric approach is required to understand these young men, appreciating how conflicted they feel in trying to accommodate sociocultural change without forfeiting the very essence of what they believe makes them men.

CHANCELLOR'S AWARDS | KANSELIERSTOEKENNINGS

Ilse Feinauer

Professor Feinauer's service at Stellenbosch University spans over 40 years, during which she built an exceptional research profile. In this time she has supervised 53 Masters students, promoted 12 doctoral students and was host professor to four post-doctoral fellows. She also succeeded in establishing an outstanding international profile, including a footprint on the African continent. She was e.g. one of the founder members of the Association for Translation Studies in Africa. Her participation in international associations and conferences led to the triennial congress of the European Society for Translation Studies being held in Stellenbosch in 2019, the first time outside of Europe. In 2022 alone she was invited five times as plenary speaker at international conferences, inter alia in Estonia, Italy and Cuba. Her continued active involvement in Afrikaans linguistics and language practice led to her becoming the first holder of the Ton and Anet Vosloo Chair in Afrikaans Language Practice in the Department of Afrikaans and Dutch. She is currently the vice-chairperson of the South African Academy for Science and Arts.

Professor Feinauer se dienstydperk aan die Universiteit Stellenbosch strek oor 40 jaar, waartydens sy 'n uitmuntende navorsingsprofiel opbou. Tot nou lewer sy 53 Magisterstudente af sowel as 12 PhD-kandidate en sy was ook gasprofessor vir 4 nadoktorale genote. Sy slaag ook daarin om 'n uitstaande internasionale profiel te vestig, insluitende 'n voetspoor op die Afrika-vasteland. Sy is byvoorbeeld een van die stigterslede van die Association for Translation Studies in Africa. Haar deelname aan internasionale verenigings en kongresse lei daartoe dat die European Society for Translation Studies se driejaarlikse kongres in 2019 op Stellenbosch aangebied word, die eerste keer buite Europa. Net in 2022 word sy vyf keer genooi as hoofspreker by internasionale kongresse, onder ander in Estland, Italië en Kuba. Haar voortgesette aktiewe betrokkenheid by die Afrikaanse taalkunde en taalpraktyk lei daartoe dat sy die eerste bekleer word van die Ton en Anet Vosloo Leerstoel in Afrikaanse Taalpraktyk in die Departement Afrikaans en Nederlands. Sy is tans ook die ondervoorsitter van die Suid-Afrikaanse Akademie vir Wetenskap en Kuns.

Frenette Southwood

Professor Southwood is one of South Africa's leading scientists in child language studies and the foremost expert on language development in Afrikaans. She co-directs the Child Language Development Research Node, where she leads a large-scale, multi-institutional initiative on early development in South Africa's 11 official languages. This project was a finalist for the prestigious UK-South Africa Newton Prize in 2020. Professor Southwood, an Alexander von Humboldt alumna, makes significant contributions to Deaf studies, specifically the development of South African Sign Language curriculum material for schools for the Deaf. Her research has considerable social impact, with the creation of language assessments and interventions for South Africa's children.

Professor Southwood is een van Suid-Afrika se mees voor-aanstaande wetenskaplikes op die gebied van kindertaal-navorsing en die voorste kenner van taalontwikkeling in Afrikaans. Sy is mededirekteur van die Kindertaalontwikkeling-navorsingsnodus, waar sy 'n grootskaalse, multi-institusionele inisiatief oor vroeë ontwikkeling in al 11 amptelike landstale lei. Hierdie projek was 'n finalis vir die gesogte VK-Suid-Afrika Newton-prys in 2020. Professor Southwood, 'n Alexander von Humboldt-alumna, lewer 'n beduidende bydrae tot Dowestudies deur die ontwikkeling van Suid-Afrikaanse Gebaretaalkurrikulummateriaal vir skole vir Dowes. Haar navorsing het aansienlike sosiale impak, vernaamlik die daarstelling van taalassesseringsinstrumente en -intervensies vir Suid-Afrika se kinders.

BREDELL, Sandra (Social Work)

A work-life perspective on the subjective wellbeing of social workers

Many South African social workers operate in extremely harsh environments and in under-resourced organisations characterised by complex socioeconomic issues and challenges. This results in an exceptionally high turnover of social workers at these organisations. This study synthesises the correlation of the subjective wellbeing of social workers in their work-life with their emotional, financial, social, spiritual, occupational, physical, intellectual and environmental dimensions of wellness. Despite neoliberal and managerial challenges affecting the resilience and ultimate flourishing of social workers, the study recommends creative wellness interventions by social workers themselves, their supervisors and organisations, statutory governing bodies and tertiary institutions.

CHIBAYA, Nyasha Hillary (Social Work)

Voices of social workers on their perceived roles in social protest actions

Proponents of radical social work endorse the development of a critical consciousness that allows for the perception of social and political contradictions. In South Africa, radical social work actions have been scant. Notwithstanding the progress that social work has made in South Africa to date, this study suggests that for authentic engagement in activism for social change, the relationship between social work and the state needs to be reconsidered. It is proposed that social workers critically engage with the structural realities of the poor and vulnerable, the discursive concepts of human rights and social justice, and ethics in social work interventions.

KLINGBEIL, Chantal (General Linguistics)

Time, Space, and Identity in Pope Memes: A Multimodal Analysis

This study explores internet memes by employing a combination of multimodal discourse analysis, as discussed by Kress and Van Leeuwen as well as Iedema, and Bakhtin's conceptualisation of discourse. The memes selected for analysis are commonly referred to as 'Pope memes'. The study probes the texts and discourses selected by meme creators, and the ways in which time and space is constructed multimodally. The findings suggest that internet memes, with their deceptive appearance of triviality, are a distinctive form of communication. In addition, it is found that arguably all communication is essentially chronotopic, multimodal and dynamic.

VALSSON, Bragi Þór (Music)

Heyr, himna smiður: The sacred a cappella SATB works of Þorkell Sigurbjörnsson (1938–2013)

This is the first study of its kind to investigate the work of the leading 20th-century Icelandic composer Þorkell Sigurbjörnsson (1938–2013). It focuses specifically on his sacred music for unaccompanied choir. The study provides a detailed biography of the composer, a comprehensive analysis of his compositional style and first performances, and recordings of all the music in question. The novelty of the study lies in the manner in which the various aspects of the research inform one another so as to achieve a coherent and integrated outcome. As such, the study represents a major contribution to the expanding field of practice-based research in music.

VAN HEUKELUM, Marie-Louise de la Marque (General Linguistics)

Predictive variables in lifelong bilingualism: An exploratory study probing the effects of L2 English on L1 Afrikaans syntax

This study aims to deepen our understanding of how a bilingual's first language develops under the influence of a second, across the person's lifespan. Harnessing newly collected experimental data from participants in South Africa and abroad, it specifically investigates the effects of English exposure and use on first-language Afrikaans speakers' Afrikaans. It is the first study to probe this language pair. The results reveal remarkable stability, particularly for earlier-acquired grammatical properties, and regardless of a speaker's geographic location. The study further highlights the importance of language-specific structural and sociolinguistic factors in determining the emergence of second-language effects on the first.

VAN ROOYEN, Renier Stephanus (Journalism)

Journalism, revolutionary technologies and preventing future harm: Proposing the Flaming Torch Media Ethics Theory and the Ten Tenets Field Guide for responsible and ethical communication on science and technology's cutting edge

Science journalists have to convey news on rapidly changing, complex and often controversial topics to the public. Yet there is no simple, practical field guide for journalists and communicators on how to communicate responsibly about technologies and discoveries so as to limit fear, misinformation and harmful disruption. Based on the analysis of several scientific controversies and interviews with top researchers and industry leaders in cutting-edge scientific fields, this study proposes the novel Flaming Torch media ethics theory and its underlying Ten Tenets as the basis for a useful field guide for more responsible and ethical public communication of revolutionary technologies and discoveries.

Anthony Naidoo

Professor Anthony Vernon Naidoo is a stalwart academic who has emphasised social impact over decades in his work – since 2000 at Stellenbosch University. This professor of Psychology, with a specialisation in counselling and clinical and community psychology, excelled in the core mandates of learning and teaching, research and innovation, transformative social impact, and academic management and leadership. Over the years, he received several research and social impact awards from Stellenbosch University and external institutions. Social impact at Stellenbosch University is advanced in various interdependent modes: through research and innovation, learning and teaching, staff and student volunteerism, and responsible and engaged citizenship; through specific social impact programmes and initiatives that are informed by research and that simultaneously inform research and innovation, learning and teaching; through social impact entities such as Maties Community Service; through the specific social impact initiatives of academic environments; and through societal partnerships. The rich curriculum vitae of Professor Naidoo demonstrates his excellent contributions in all these modes of social impact. Professor Naidoo made direct inputs in the field of service learning and has helped to develop a scholarship of service learning in local and global contexts. Professor Naidoo, who retires at the end of 2022, is an worthy and exemplary receiver of the Chancellor's Award.

The impact of forensic DNA profiling on gender privacy

This dissertation investigates whether the disclosure of sex in a forensic DNA profile infringes gender privacy. The purpose of a biological sex marker in forensic casework and the concept of gender privacy was examined. Changes to legislation were recommended to provide for a right to gender privacy, as an extended right to privacy in terms of the Constitution.

Sustainable development for rural women artisanal miners in Malawi: Obligations under the African Charter and Maputo Protocol

In Africa, more women than men are involved in artisanal and small-scale mining, and yet it is often assumed that the mining sector is not a place for women. Thus, there is a need to understand women's position in artisanal and small-scale mining. This issue is raised at a time when increasing attention is being paid to legal empowerment as a strategy to get women out of poverty. This study analyses rural women artisanal miners in Malawi and their position in artisanal and small-scale mining. It considers the rights and related obligations as provided in the African Charter and the Maputo Protocol, which create a matrix of rights and obligations central in addressing the rights of rural women artisanal miners in Malawi.

VAN DER MERWE, Stephan (Private Law)

Developing a procedural framework for advanced debtor protection: The case of emolument attachment orders

This study investigates the historical context within which the South African emolument attachment order developed and the composition of the current framework that regulates this popular civil debt enforcement mechanism. Identifying specific deficiencies in the framework, the study demonstrates why, despite recent judicial and legislative developments, the framework still fails to address serious debtor abuse at the hands of unscrupulous creditors. Finally, having regard to the approaches of the two prominent foreign jurisdictions of England and the United States of America, recommendations and proposals are made to develop a procedural framework for advanced debtor protection.

Abbot Ĕnbāqom and Islam: The Historical-Theological significance of Anqās'ā Amin's contribution to Christian-Muslim engagement in sixteenth century Ethiopia

In the aftermath of the 16th-century Islamic conquest of Ethiopia by Ahmad Ibn Ibrahim al-Ghazi (Ahmad Grāñ), the Yemeni Christian convert Abbot Ĕnbāqom took to writing to Grāñ with the hope of convincing him to change direction and convert to Christianity. While the apologetic argumentation came to naught, the Abbot's correspondence entitled *Anqās'ā Amin*, which is translated as 'Door of the Faith', became an important piece of Ethiopian Christian literature, which this study investigates as an attempt at Christian-Muslim engagement.

GUSHA, Tapiwa Huggins (New Testament)

The implications of honour and shame in Matthew 5:38-42 and in unhu philosophy as a response to political violence in Zimbabwe

This study compares the functioning of the socio-scientific concepts of honour and shame in the first-century Greco-Roman world to the role of these values in contemporary unhu philosophy. It specifically investigates how Matthew 5:38-42 presents Jesus as reinterpreting the values of honour and shame. This is done to determine whether an analogous reinterpretation of these values in unhu philosophy can help curb the ongoing political violence in Zimbabwe. The study concludes that the Matthean Jesus's reinterpretation of non-violent conduct as honourable should inform the Zimbabwean churches' engagement with political institutions.

Responses of African Pentecostal churches to African refugees in Düsseldorf between 2015 and 2020: A case study of mission and migration

The churches' response includes charity, compassion, and the recognition of refugees' religious and social identities. Churches provide contexts for refugees to mediate their reception and integration in the environment. The social and spiritual survival tactics of this vulnerable group challenge transformative discourses and practices to link faith to social policy, and faith commitments to advocacy. This case study of African refugees shows how and why an African faith community can facilitate integration in a Western context while also being challenged and transformed. It contributes to understandings of the social and religious dimensions of transformation located between mission and transnational migration.

KITAYIMBWA, Lydia Nabunya Nsaale (Practical Theology)

Communicating the Gospel in a digital age: A case study of the Dioceses of Kampala and Namirembe in the Anglican Church of Uganda

In response to the increasing use of digital media in daily life and in the work of the church, this study examines how the Gospel is communicated in the Anglican Church of Uganda. Effective communication requires that the church understands and adapts to continuously changing communication mediums. However, this study finds that there is a lack of knowledge and appropriate approaches to guide the effective use of digital communication by the church. Therefore, to guide the formation and nurturing of online faith communities, the study provides a contextual digital communication strategy that is informed by trinitarian and incarnational theology.

Navigating the Threshold: An African Feminist Reading of the Hagar Narrative in Judaism, Christianity, and Islam

This study focuses on the experiences of Hagar/Hajar as represented in the three monotheistic traditions of Judaism, Christianity and Islam. The scriptures from these traditions locate her differently, bringing into conversation considerations of who Hagar/Hajar is, not only in relation to the specific faith traditions, but also to what these traditions offer for interreligious dialogue and sense-making. The study shows that the story of Hagar/Hajar becomes an excellent 'third space' where authentic engagement among the three religious traditions can take place. Furthermore, the memory of Hagar/Hajar is kept alive through the liminal identities of South African women who share similar experiences.
