

## **TYGERBERG CAMPUS STUDENT FEES INFORMATION**

This is an updated notice that is only applicable to students registered for programmes in the Faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences (FMHS).

#### 1. REGISTRATION DATES FOR 2019

Registration dates for 2019 will be communicated in a separate notice by the Registrar's office before the end of the year.

#### 2. COMPULSORY FIRST INSTALMENT OF STUDY AND ACCOMMODATION FEES FOR 2019:

The following amounts are payable before date of registration:

No separate student account will be distributed during registration reflecting the above amounts. The amounts automatically become due and payable once the student registers either online or physically at the university.

#### **NEW IMMEDIATE PAYMENT METHOD:**

#### 3. OUTSTANDING FEES AT REGISTRATION

Kindly note that all outstanding amounts should be settled before a student will be allowed to register for 2019. With regard to outstanding debt, FMHS students who receive a bursary for 2019 that covers at least the outstanding debt as well as the compulsory first instalment of study fees for 2019 (see section "2", above) will also be allowed to register if proof of this bursary is provided to the Tygerberg Campus Undergraduate Bursaries and Loans Office.

## 4. MODES OF PAYMENT OF STUDENT ACCOUNTS

Student accounts can be settled within the following two modes of payment:

Option1: Payment in three instalments

ATREGISTRATION	Compulsory first instalment of Study and Accommodation Fees
31 MAY	At least 75% of the remainder of the total student fees account, after the amount paid by date of registration has been deducted.
30 SEPTEMBER	The outstanding balance of student account.

Option 2: Debit order that consists of the following instalments:

ATREGISTRATION	Compulsory first instalment of Study and Accommodation Fees
1 APRIL UP TO AND UNTIL 1 NOVEMBER	A further eight instalments of the debit order are payable on
	the first day of the month.

Applications for the debit order option close on 8 March. The necessary forms can be obtained from the web at http://www.maties.com/tuis.html available under "Fees", "Payment Options" or at <a href="mailto:seand@sun.ac.za">seand@sun.ac.za</a>. Applications after 8 March will be considered subject to prepayment of the minimum debit order payments due since 1 April.

If study fees of South African students are paid in full on or before 31 March, a request for a 3% rebate on the tuition fees (subject to conditions as stipulated in the *University Yearbook*) can be submitted at Student Fees. International students, including non-residential International students, and Namibians, are liable for the full tuition fees on the day of registration. Details are available at the different International Offices.

### 5. ACTIVATION OF STUDENT CARD FOR 2019

Student cards can only be issued / re-activated once the 2018 student account has been settled in full and the first instalment for study and accommodation fees reflects on the student account.

Blocks may only be lifted for the activation of a student card if the 2018 student account has been settled in full and the student can provide proof of the following:

- 1. An External bursary (not SU) indicating the costs that will be covered by the funder on the letterhead of the funder with their e-mail address and contact details. SU bursary students do not need to provide a letter and can activate their cards directly after registration.
- 2. Students who have received NSFAS funding in 2018 will automatically be able to register.
- 3. An official policy that will be paid out in the 2019 academic year and that will cover at least the first compulsory instalment.
- 4. A loan (e.g. Bank loan, Fundi or Helpmekaar study loan) where the loan amount is sufficient to cover at least first compulsory instalment, also indicating the date of payment.
- 5. If the bursary, loan or policy of a student is not sufficient to cover the full first compulsory instalment and a student can provide proof that they had applied for a study loan, but that it was not granted, then the following down payment arrangement can be made, subject to acceptance of the stipulations of the agreement:
  - a. The first compulsory instalment (study and accommodation fees) can be settled in equal instalments by no later than 31 March.
  - b. The first instalment is payable immediately. The block will only be lifted once the first

instalment reflects on the student account and the completed form is processed by Student fees.

c. If a payment arrangement is made in January the equal instalments are:

d. If a payment arrangement is made in February the equal instalments are:

The payment arrangement form will only be available on request in January 2019 at Student Fees and is subject to approval from the division.

### 6. DISCONTINUATION OF STUDIES BEFORE 31 MARCH

When a student discontinues studies before or on 31 March all study fees are reversed. Residence students will be held liable for the residence fees until the vacated place has been filled.

#### 7. INTERNET FEES

Internet fees usually closed down at the end of each year for financial reporting purposes. This however impacted on postgraduate students still requiring internet access during December. The internet access will close down at end of year for NSFAS students only (there will still be Pay2Go access).

Internet access for students of the previous year not registered by 30 March in the following year will terminate on 1 April 2019.
