




STUDY ABROAD AT STELLENBOSCH UNIVERSITY

Go on an Exchange

Students from partner universities can apply to study for a semester of two on exchange engaged in academic credit-bearing programmes. Prospective exchange students must be nominated by their home institutions to participate in an exchange at SU.

If successful, students have the opportunity to join the Matie Buddy Programme, an exciting cross-cultural buddy programme that allows exchange students to connect with local South African students before their arrival and also during their time in Stellenbosch to help them settle and adapt to living in Stellenbosch.

Freemovers

Students enrolled at education institutions anywhere in the world are eligible to apply for a semester or two to study abroad as a Freemover student at Stellenbosch University. Freemovers take up to 60 South African credits per semester (30 ECTS/15 USA credits) for the purpose of transferring academic credits back to their home university. Fees are payable per semester.

Research Students

As an excellent research university with great facilities, the institution attracts students for short research visits. Students have the opportunity to apply to work on their research or join a research group under the guidance of an academic host.

Structured Research Internship

Students doing a research internship at SU will not only gain valuable knowledge and experience in their fields but also experience the rich culture of the country. The research internships are credit bearing and can be transferred to count towards their degrees at their home universities.
