Snake bite

The summer season is the time when snakes become active.

If a snake bite occurs the most important thing to do is to get the person to a medical facility as soon as possible. Do not waist time by cutting, sucking or fiddling with the bite site. Phone the hospital and let them know that you are on your way.

Some snakes can spit e.g. Mozambique spitting cobra and rinkhals. Immediately rince eyes with water for at least 20 minutes.

Not all snakes are poisonous, the common house snake, mole snake and skaapsteker are amongst those considered harmless.
