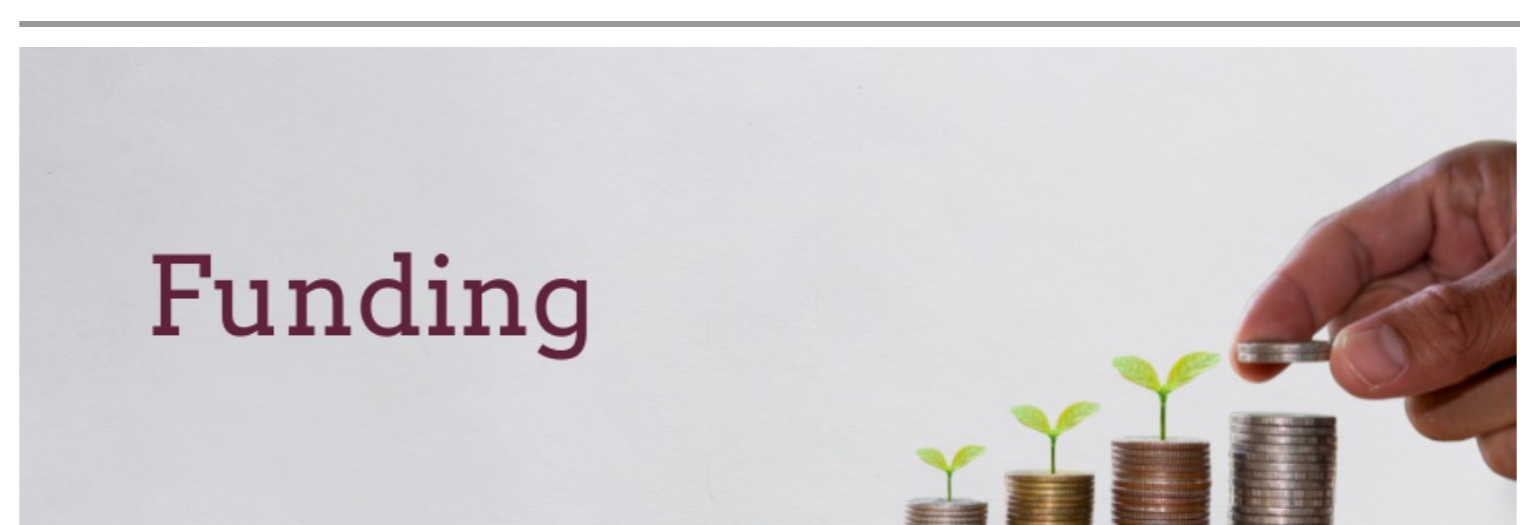

Overseas Conference Grant

The Postgraduate Office Overseas Conference Grant (OCG) is a supplementary award to attend an international conference outside of South Africa to present a paper or a poster. Applicants must be in their final year of their Master's degree or registered for a doctoral degree at Stellenbosch University. The maximum award is R15 000. Preference will be given to applicants invited to deliver oral presentations.

Closing dates:

- 30 September 2022 (for conferences between September to December 2022).
- 1 December 2022 (for conferences between January to April 2023).

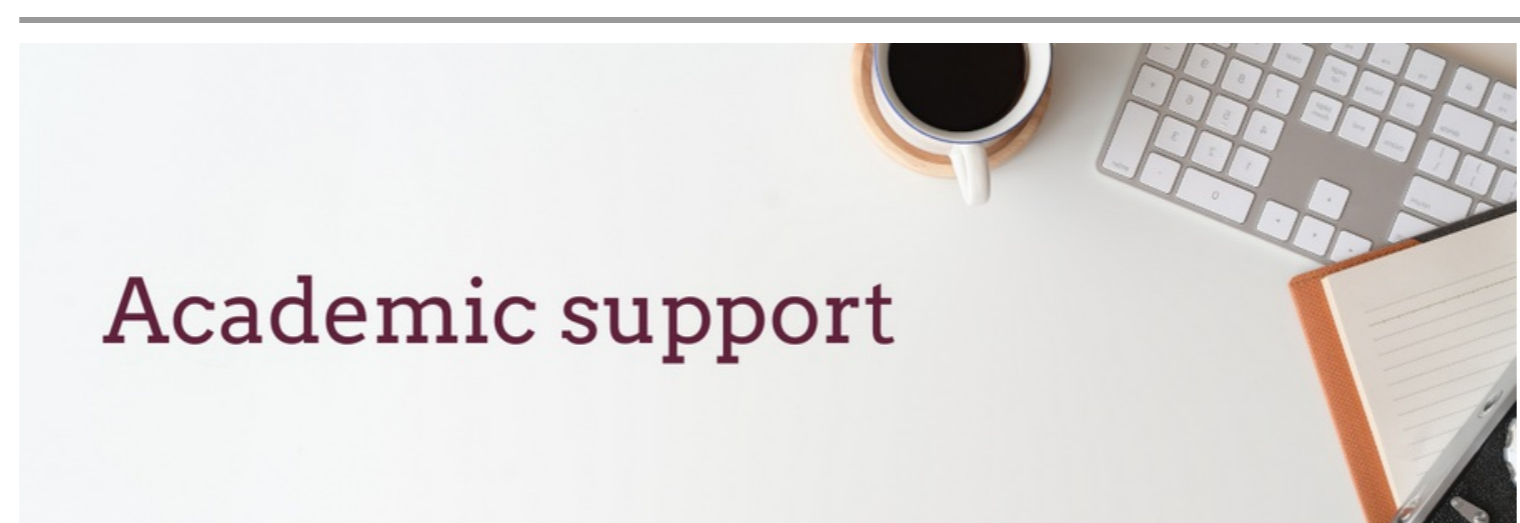

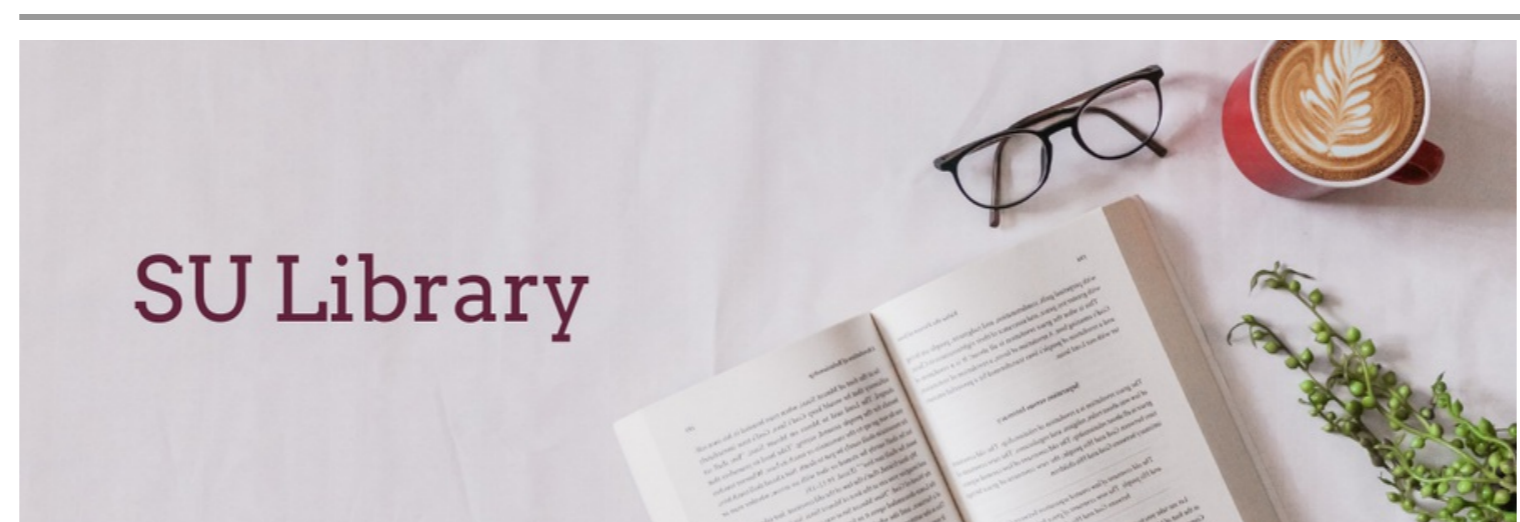
